










# WINTER HOME MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

-  Have a heating professional check and service your heating system
-  Detach and put away all hoses and install insulated faucet covers
-  Check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in your home. If any are older than 10 years old, replace them
-  Clean out gutters and downspouts and have your chimney inspected and cleaned if you have one
-  Test your emergency generator if you have one and run all gas-powered lawn equipment until the fuel is gone
-  Make sure the caulking around your doors and windows is adequate to help keep heat in and the cold out
-  Clean out dryer ducting and vents as lint buildup can create a fire hazard
